# VALE: DARREN TANDY (12/05/1967 – 24/12/2015)



Darren joined WDTC as an eight year old junior in 1975 and soon excelled in the sport. Within a few years he was playing Junior league and as a teenager played Junior State tennis. He became a regular member of the Junior State Tennis Programme and represented WA as a member of the Pizzey Cup Team. Darren was one of the first and youngest candidates to complete his tennis coaching accreditation levels.

In 1986 he was appointed Club coach at Wanneroo Tennis Club. This was the first of many coaching appointments throughout his short life.

Darren's international career began in 1988 when he travelled to Germany as an "import club tennis competition player" and during the season undertook some coaching. This continued for several seasons as he coached, assisted and introduced many prominent local players to overseas competitions and clubs.

1992 was his first venture into the ATP Tour. Darren teamed up with James Sekulov and Andrew Ille as coach and manager on the European leg of the tour. (Darren had previously coached James in Perth from a very young age until he was accepted into the AIS where he rose to a Junior World Ranking of No.2). Darren's ATP touring as a coach continued in 2011 when he teamed with another WDTC member, Matt Ebden, as Matt's coach. He remained as Matt's coach on and off at major events up to the US Open last year when he suffered his stoke.

In 2000 Darren became coach of the Floreat Park Tennis Club, a position he held for a number of years.

For some 35 years Darren retained his association and membership with WDTC. He represented the Club at State League for several years and assisted in forming many of our teams including the Club's first State League team.

Darren was a well known and highly respected player, coach and mentor to many players throughout the tennis world. I am sure I speak for a number of us in the Club and many outside of the Club; he will be sorely missed. May you rest in peace, Darren.

#### Summer League

And in the first week of finals (weekend semis 12/3/2016 12.30 pm start) we will have all 4 grass court teams playing at home which will be State League, Mens Div 1, Ladies Div 3 and Mens Div 10. The midweek teams will start finals a week later.

Success should not just be measured by teams in finals. I have been really pleased with the development of some of our new teams (quite a few playing senior tennis for the first time), the cooperation between midweek and weekend teams, the good spirit demonstrated by all of our players, the support of teams by all members and parents and despite some challenges with the new Tennis Australia systems/ratings the perseverance of all captains and players. We have repeatedly raised our concerns regarding these changes with Tennis West and we are hopeful some progress can be made after the end of the season. Particularly with making sure there is an effective ratings review process that accurately reflects the player's improvement (this is critical to our young developing members).

This year we are trying something a little different with a qualification tournament commencing on the **19<sup>th</sup> March** (we will accommodate league players playing in finals this weekend) and the seeded tournament being played on the **2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> April**.
