First Aid/Defib

Our President has organised St Johns to do a training session at the Club in early 2015 and we need to get as many members as possible to the session. It will be on a Wednesday or Friday at 4 pm. We will let everyone know in due course. Peter Doherty and I attended the session and it was very good.

We have purchased a new and improved First Aid kit which is located in the Day Captain's room. The kit can be transported to where it is required and allows us to provide first aid more quickly and efficiently. The kit includes a cold pack (chemical) that is activated by crushing. In the Captain's room there is an A4 sheet on the wall to record any use of items within the portable kit or items in the kit on the wall in the kitchen. This way we can make sure both kits are well stocked all the time.

In the event of crutches being required in an emergency please contact me as I have a pair at home.

We will be conducting a risk assessment on our club 'first aiders' capability so can members let me know of any first aid or life saving qualification.

From the History Vault

For this edition I have picked 1971 as our year in focus. At that time Gary Penberthy was WA's number one Men's player (members may be interested to note he was in WA's top 5 ranked players from 1968 to 1982 which is an outstanding achievement). Haven't given up hope of getting him back on the court at some stage.

The significance of 1971 from a WDTC's perspective was that it was our first Junior league shield, Boys Under 16 Pennant Div 3 1971 made up of Kim Ven Der Beek (Captain), Bryan Knox, Paul Perrott, Ian Campbell, Glen Bailey, Graham Perry & Steven Shippard.

I couldn't find any record of their names on Tennis Vault or current club members so perhaps all of them drifted away from tennis. Please let me know if any members know what any of them are up to now.
