Court Booking System Opening

Speaking of our Club Captain, as from the 1st February 2017, Mike Underwood has taken over responsibility for hiring out our courts to non-members. The Club has invested in a new court booking system developed by Tennis Australia.

An official "opening" for the new system is to be conducted by the Mayor of Stirling at 4:00pm on Saturday 25th February 2017. Also in attendance will be the CEO and President of Tennis West and our local Councillors, Elizabeth Re and Stephanie Proud. All members are invited to attend.

Court Light poles

The Club's application to the Department for Sport & Recreation for 1/3 funding for replacement light poles for courts 1 to 4 was rejected. The Club is now working with the City of Stirling to confirm the urgency of the poles replacement and whether or not the City of Stirling will increase their contribution to the costs from 33% to 50%.

Courts 5 to 8 Replacement

The Club's application to the Department for Sport & Recreation for replacement of courts 5 to 8 with synthetic grass and lights was rejected. The Club is now re-considering its options.

Court Hire Update

Just thought I would update all members on the court hire arrangements at WDTC. From the 1st Feb the club has taken back control of all court hire from Global Tennis so all revenue collected will go to the club. You also may have noticed some work going on next to court 5 and your club was selected as one of the pilot clubs to participate in an automated court hire system which has now been installed and is operational. This system includes a security keypad gate (next to court 1) which is linked to an online booking system that even turns the lights on and off. We will have Tennis West's new CEO Michael Roberts and President Wayne Firns along with our friends from the City of Stirling including the Mayor Giovanni Italiano officially open the system at a presentation at **4 pm on Sat the 25th Feb** with some refreshments afterwards. It would be fantastic to get some photos with lots of our members included.

One of the key objectives of the Tennis Australia programme is to open up our courts for hire to their local communities which no doubt will lead to more people playing tennis regularly and new members. And it is our aim to hire out our grass courts 5 to 8 on occasions subject to ensuring courts are not required by members and they are in good condition.

How you can help? If you get an enquiry about court hire please give them my mobile number or if available I will come over and have a chat. If any member takes a casual booking please record the court hirers name, mobile, email address and the court surface on an envelope in the Day Captain's office and just send me an sms and I will collect it later. The process from there would be for me to contact them and ascertain their regular court hiring needs and set them up on the system. My contact details and the hourly court hire rates are all on a poster next to the Day Captain's office and outside the club near the main gate.

Club Champs Launch



CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1. Entry fee must accompany form; entry is available for financial members only. ENTRY FEE: \$12 PER EVENT.
- 2. Competitors are responsible to check their playing time.
- 3. Players will be entered into either the qualification or seeded tournament based on tournament numbers and seeding. The winner/winners of qualification will gain automatic entry into the seeded tournament.
- 4. The organisers will endeavour to accommodate scheduling requests where possible.
- 5. All competitors should be available from 9.30 am. To commence play at 10 am on all days of competition.
- 6. Players 15 minutes late without prior advice after being called for play will be disqualified.
- 7. Tournament will be conducted under general rules of play as set by Tennis Australia and ITF. Any disputes will be resolved by Tournament Referee Mike Underwood (0422 922 467).
- 8. Time allowed between matches will be no more than twenty minutes, provided courts are available.
- 9. A five minute hit-up is allowed before matches commence.
- 10. Each match to be best of either, 3 Tie Break sets or 2 Tie Break sets with a Super Tie Break decider, unless otherwise advised by the Tournament Committee. Play shall be continuous. The Club reserves the right to change the format subject to entry numbers and any other requirement.
- 11. In the event of an injury, a once only 10 minute injury time will be allowed before a match is forfeited.
- 12. Events may have a consolation event for first round losers, depending on numbers. Consolation Play will be: First to 9 games with a Tie Break at 8 games all. Please Note:- a bye in the first round of any event constitutes a win and rules you ineligible to enter the consolation event.
- 13. The draw will be on the front door of the tennis club on the Thursday evening prior to the first day of play. The draw will be emailed to all players if a valid email address is provided on the application form.
- 14. All players must be available for all days of the event. The Final of each event must be at the scheduled time.
- 15. Your entry will be deemed acceptance of the above conditions.
- 16. Trophies/prizes will be presented at the Annual Dinner.

VETERANS MENS/LADIES AND MIXED DOUBLES 2015

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY
