Members' Survey

Thank you to Peter Doherty who was largely responsible for compiling the survey and its results, to Joe McCarthy for the use of Global Tennis' Survey Monkey and to the 136 members who completed the survey. A summary of the results appears later in the Player.

SURVEY RESULTS

Following is a summary of the results of our members' survey. If anyone is interested in more detail they can talk to anyone on the Management Committee.

- 1. 35% (136) of members responded to the survey, 60% of responses being from Full members
- 2. 86% of the respondents were over 40 years of age
- 3. 50% of respondents have been members for more than 11 years
- 4. 75% of respondents were at least satisfied with Social Tennis, Competition Tennis, Facilities, Coaching, Management, Social functions, Club Communications
- 5. About 50% of respondents thought that the Club Facilities needed at least minor improvements, with the Hall Building and Court surrounds being the priorities.
- 6. 85% of respondents thought that additional costs for new facilities should be funded from hiring out the facilities or fund raising by activities/more sponsors
- 7. Regarding the question of converting grass courts to another surface, 41% agreed, 27% disagreed and 32% were undecided
- 8. In response to the question of playing night tennis, 43% would be at least interested in playing on synthetic grass and 21% would be interested in playing on hard courts
- 9. Interest levels of respondents to additional tennis activities were:

- 10. Following is a selection of **individual** responses for other Club Improvements:
 - Cash Register Till replaced with a stock checking till to minimise bar committee duties.
 - Fee discount for young adults still studying
 - Get more members in 30s & 40s... Maybe Mixed Doubles Night tournaments
 - Encourage younger members to do their bit on management.
 - It would appear that here are many juniors who play at our club as can be seen on the hard courts regularly. We need to somehow get their parents involved.
 - · More play and stays
 - Smaller activities such as 100s Clubs, chocolate wheels, raffles could be introduced in a way that the
 members not only can "win" some benefits but it builds good team work and camaraderie good club
 spirit and brings people to the club as they must be present to collect their winnings
 - New membership categories Fathers and Son/ Mother and daughter at half the Family rate.
 - more flexible and friendly approach towards potential new members re court hire. allow play /court hire
 other surfaces than just hard court.
 - Set up a gym and coffee shop.
 - Promote / advertise that people can join in social play for fee
 - Advertise the bar facilities to surrounding sports clubs. They may be able to use as an after match


