Overall a successful season that had its fair of challenges. And we also had our share of tough losses which no doubt a few of us are still getting over. - Our Mens Doubles Wednesday Div 2 won their grand final against a very determined City Beach team. Team was Matt Connell, James Haas, Aubrey Hingston, Roland Townend and well led by Gareth Fricker (see photo below). This was an outstanding achievement with the final played on difficult synthetic grass courts and our team won the division from fourth place.
- Fantastic achievement by our Mixed Div 3 Tuesday night team in winning the club's first Mixed team division. This was a new squad that won their semi and final coping effectively with wet conditions and injuries. Team squad comprised of Joel Forsyth Captain, Janet Paterson, Tom Paterson, Tammy Reddell, Serene Staunton and Gareth Fricker (see photo below Gareth missing).
- Our club had two senior MVPs Peter Doherty (Men Div 2 over 50) and Noriko Thompson (Wednesday Ladies Open Doubles). Peter and Noriko will receive their awards at a Tennis West function on the 5<sup>th</sup> May. We had several other league players who deserved MVP awards and only missed out by one or two wins.

- We had 18 senior teams with 14 making finals and 5 reaching grand finals (a very good club effort). And our Mens Div 8 & 9 were very unlucky with some external factors outside of their control affecting the top 4.
- We had the opportunity for some of our good young players to gain valuable experience in a very tough Mens Division 2 with some of the teams stronger than Division 1.
- We entered a team in a mixed comp with Northern Districts for the first team. Many thanks to Serene Staunton for Captaining the team which had a very large squad.
- Excellent cooperation by all captains and teams (best I have experienced) with all teams playing in the right spirit and being excellent hosts. From my side this is critical as it helps our club attract members from other clubs.
- Lastly I would just like to recognise Sean Macfarlane (and his two teams on Wednesday night and Sunday over 35). Sean was captain of both teams and led the teams to semi finals in two strong divisions. Captaining one team is tough two teams is a nightmare. Well done Sean.




